C&G 19/20/029 **Apologies for Absence**
Apologies were received and APPROVED for Councillor L Morton

C&G 19/20/030 **Declarations of Interest on Items on the Agenda**

C&G 19/20/031 **The minutes of the Last Meeting held on Tuesday 19 November 2019**

C&G 19/20/032 **Matters Arising**
The Clerk advised that work was still required to the brick planters and the brick around the grassed areas a Low Row. **RECOMMENDED** that the Clerk obtain a date for completion of the work from the Groundstaff.

C&G 19/20/033 **Cemetery and Grounds Update**
The Clerk updated Members on the following:

- Repair work for tractors

It was suggested that a trial on one of the black planters be undertaken with shrubs being planted. It was felt that the best location for this would be along Loaning Burn. If it was successful at this location then it could potentially be rolled out to the other areas within the Parish.

- ii) Councillors Lee and Andrews along with the Clerk purchase some shrubs for the loaning burn planter.

C&G 19/20/034 **Wildflower Scheme**
The Clerk updated members on advice given by the Cemetery Superintendent. There were three areas proposed around Thorpe Road Roundabout and the entrance to Easington Village and it was agreed that these areas should be pegged out so that the visual impact could be assessed prior to the planting. **RECOMMENDED:** that the Clerk instruct the Cemetery Superintendent to peg out the areas identified.
